We are seeking a part-time Registered Nurse to join our team in the first and only privately owned bulk-billing general practice specialising in homeless health and vulnerable populations in New South Wales.

About the role

We believe everyone should have access to high quality primary healthcare, regardless of income, housing status, visas, LGA or level of need. Our team supports this philosophy by taking a person-centred human rights approach and providing highly professional wrap around support to anyone in need, ranging from early intervention to acute crisis intervention and post-crisis supports.

You will be working in a newly renovated consultation room alongside a General Practitioner, with close support also provided by a Practice Coordinator, an administrative team and the Haymarket Foundation's team of case managers, social workers and allied health professionals.

Our ideal candidate will have an interest and experience in chronic disease management, cycle of care, substance misuse and mental health. Our goal is to create long-term associations with our patients as we support them into, and to maintain long-term housing in the community.

Typical duties include management of, immunisations, wound care, assisting with minor procedures, stock control, health assessments, management of chronic disease, ECG, spirometry, and infection control. Robust management of recall and reminder correspondence is also a key part of this role, which will be supported by our administration and case management teams.



This position is part-time, with a minimum appointment time of 20 minutes on a bulk-billing basis both face to face and via telehealth.
